Brockfield Hall is only six miles from York, but is in parkland little changed from when Benjamin Agar built the farm and walledgarden in 1799 and his house in 1804. The house is also home to the country's largest collection of paintings by artists of the Staithes Group – Yorkshire's impressionist artists. The Staithes Art Club (1901-1907) had some thirty members, many of whom trained in Paris at the Academie Julien, and are thus close cousins-in-art of the Newlyn School in Cornwall. Brockfield Hall was recently restored and was the winner of the Sotheby's Historic Houses Restoration Award 2023.






